



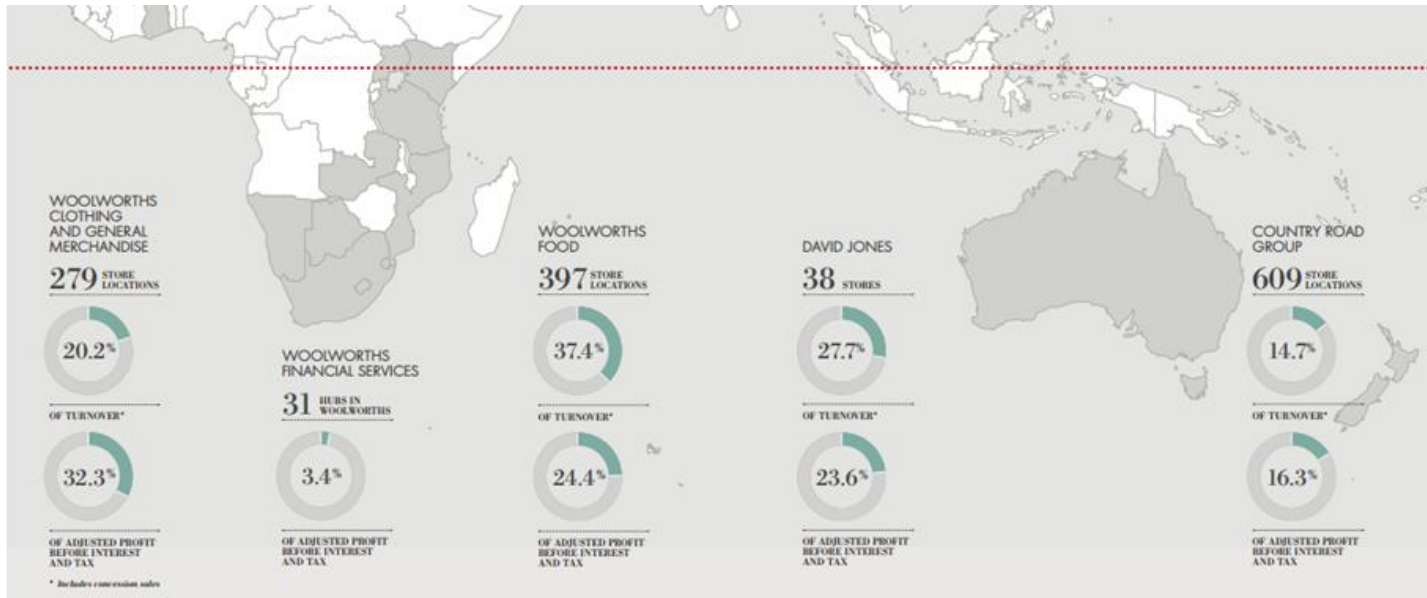

NATIONAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN

South Africa's National Development Plan is a detailed blueprint for how the country can eliminate poverty and reduce inequality by the year 2030. The Medium Term Strategic Framework (MTSF) was the first framework drawn up following the adoption of the NDP in 2012. It sets out actions needed to implement the NDP over the first five years of the plan, and provides a framework for the building supporting plans. The MTSF identified 14 outcomes-based priorities of the NDP that need urgent attention by 2019.

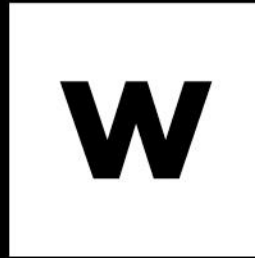


SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT GOALS
